

**OPEN CALL:
THE STUDIO PROJECT INTERNSHIP PROGRAM
2016-2017**

The Boulder Museum of Contemporary Art (BMoCA) is currently accepting applications for *The Studio Project* Internship Program, a yearlong internship open to middle and high school aged youth in Boulder County.

Interns work closely to develop programming and events for *The Studio Project*, BMoCA's premiere program creating experiences with contemporary art and dialogue about art, art making, and issues that affect teens. Interns learn about museums, work with museum staff, and participate in the behind-the-scene workings of the museum. Interns meet and assist exhibiting artists, visit other museums and galleries and collaborate with teen organizations throughout Boulder and Denver.

This internship is an excellent opportunity for students interested in collaborative program development and community arts outreach. It will also require students to discuss interests and issues that concern teens today. Interns will meet with the Studio Project educator and other Studio Project Interns on Tuesday afternoons from 4-5:30pm throughout the school year, August-May. Accepted applicants are expected to commit to the entire school year.

Interns must have a sincere interest in being creative, helping the community, learning about the museum world and collaborating with other teens and adults.

Time commitment: Meetings are 1 ½ hours a week, Art Lounges are 4 hours on one Friday 4 times a year, and 10 community service hours to be completed at BMoCA throughout the year. Interns must commit to the entirety of the program. This internship qualifies for high school community service hours. Many students are able to count this internship for their Senior Project. This internship is unpaid.
